The element that defines your cover most

The slats are the visible, working part of the cover: they determine **light transmission**, **water heating**, **strength** and **appearance**. We manufacture in three materials, each designed for a different priority. This guide shows you how they differ so you can choose with certainty.

BUDGET OPTION

PVC Slat

The most widely used and most affordable. Lightweight, very strong and with excellent insulation. Opaque: it transmits no light, but it retains heat and reduces evaporation.

HEATS THE WATER

Solar Polycarbonate

Multiwall (cellular) polycarbonate with a dark underside that captures the sun and transfers it to the water. It heats the pool naturally, with no energy consumption.

Clear Polycarbonate

Transparent polycarbonate that lets you see the water even with the cover closed. The premium option for looks and brightness, ideal for indoor pools.

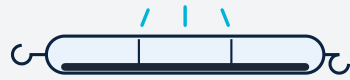
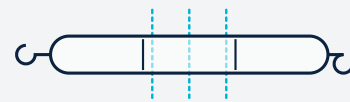
Guaranteed durability

INGERCLIMA INSTALLATION

Made from **high-density PVC**, these are the most affordable and the most widely installed option. Lightweight, highly resistant to pool chemicals and needing minimal maintenance. They transmit no light to the water, but they are the ones that **insulate best**: they hold the heat built up during the day and slow evaporation, cutting the pool's energy costs.

ADVANTAGES

- The best strength · light weight · price ratio.
- The best insulation: reduces evaporation and retains heat.
- Limescale and dirt show far less than on the clear slats.
- Wide colour range to blend in with the surroundings.

POINTS TO CONSIDER

- It does not provide direct solar heating to the water.
- Opaque: the water is not visible with the cover closed.

General use and tighter budgets where insulation, safety and durability come first, with no need for solar gain.

HEATS THE WATER FOR FREE

Solar Polycarbonate



Polycarbonate with a **hollow multiwall structure** and a dark underside: it absorbs solar radiation and transfers it straight to the water, working as a **natural solar collector**. It can raise the water temperature by **up to 8 °C** with no energy consumption whatsoever. There is also a version with a **fourth dark anti-algae chamber** that reduces algae build-up at the joint between slats.

ADVANTAGES

- Heats the water with the sun, at no energy cost.

- Tri-extruded polycarbonate: resists impact, UV and hail.
- 4-chamber version with a dark anti-algae chamber.

POINTS TO CONSIDER

- Semi-transparent: the water is not as clearly visible as with the clear slat.
- Mid-range price, above PVC.

Anyone who wants to maximise solar heating and extend the swimming season using the sun, without increasing their pool heating bill.

MAXIMUM BRIGHTNESS

Clear Polycarbonate



The **premium option for looks**. Clear polycarbonate lets you **see the water even with the cover closed** and keeps the space bright, letting natural light through. It shares the toughness of tri-extruded polycarbonate (impact, UV and hail). Particularly recommended for **indoor pools** or design projects where the look of the water comes first.

ADVANTAGES

- Maximum light transmission: the pool stays visible and bright.
- The water is visible with the cover closed.
- Tri-extruded polycarbonate: resists impact, UV and hail.
- Crystal, platinum, opal and blue finishes.

POINTS TO CONSIDER

- It is the highest-priced option (premium).
- Limescale and dirt marks show more than on coloured slats.
- It is not optimised to heat the water the way the solar slat is.
